

Note to Parents - Making the Most of the Holidays!

Dear Parent,

We encourage you to make the holiday homework a joyful bonding experience with your child. These activities are designed to be fun, engaging, and light, helping your little one learn through play and creativity.

Please keep the following in mind:

- Work on one or two activities per week to avoid overload.
- Involve your child in daily routines and nature-based tasks to enhance real-world learning.
- Use recycled or easily available materials wherever possible.
- Motivate your child by appreciating their efforts, however small.

Avoid writing-heavy tasks. Support your child in pasting, drawing, speaking, and exploring instead.

Submission Guidelines:

- Kindly collect your child's work in a homemade folder (made from an old cardboard box, cereal box, or paper bag).
- Let your child help decorate the folder using waste materials like newspaper cuttings, buttons, fabric scraps, or gift wrap leftovers.
- Label the folder with the child's name and class.
- Submit the folder when school reopens.

This approach will not only reinforce learning but also teach children the importance of sustainability (aligned with SDG Goals) and creativity!

One day, Bunny wanted to build a house.




She found a circle and said, "This can be my window!"

Then she saw a square — "Perfect for the wall!"




Next, she picked a triangle — "This will be my roof!"

And then a rectangle — "I'll use this as my door!" 29




Bunny worked all day and built a tiny shape house.

Task 2: My First Picture Book

- Draw shapes around each object (e.g., circle around a ball, square around a book).








SUMMER SCAVENGER HUNT



Place a check very next to each item you find. The first one to find all the items wins.
















SUMMER COUNTING



Count the summer items and write the number in the box.














SUMMER MAZE PUZZLE



Help the girl reach the beach to join her friends.









