Task 3 - General Awareness

Indigo Hunt: Go on an "Indigo Treasure Hunt" around the house or neighbourhood. Look for toys, books, or decorations that have indigo in them.











Task 4 :Life Skill

Laundry Detective: Help fold clothes, and play a game of "Colour Detective" to spot which clothes are indigovs blue or purple.

Task 5 Math - Draw few water drop friends for Drippy and on a sheet, doodle them with blue colour. Doodle patterns can be spiral, wave zig zag etc.

Task 6-Reading Time – Select your favourite story book and wear your cozy blue colour night suit to read with your grandaprents.



Task 7 - Chat with Grandparents

Engage in a conversation with your grandparents and ask them about their favourite memory related to a body of water, whether it is a river, sea, pond, or stream.

Yellow - Bright and Happy.


Task 10: Life Skill – Help clean your toy shelf – find yellow toys, count and sort them.

Give smileys to 3 people in your family whom you love and trust.








Task 13: Orange Calm Zone Try "sun" poses or orange-themed animal poses (fox, tiger) with calm breathing and involve your family members.

Task 15: Pattern Play: Create red patterns (red-red-blue-red-red...) and talk about repeating sequences.





I wear clean and ironed clothes.




